

The following safety site rules are applicable at the worksites managed by Port of Rotterdam (PoR):



- Obey the maximum speed and traffic signs on site.
- Parking is only allowed in the dedicated parking spaces.
- Report to reception or your PoR contact person upon entering the site.
- Smoking or eating is only allowed in the designated areas.
- It is prohibited to make or publicise photo's or video without authorisation.
- Report incidents, defects, security issues and unsafe situations to your PoR contact person.
- Use the prescribed Personal Protective Equipment.

In case you are assigned to repair or maintenance works:



- Familiarise with the emergency details or add the emergency contact in your phone.
- Check if you have reception in your work area to contact the emergency services.
- Your PoR contact person confirms the assignment and informs you of any site activities or conditions that may impact on the work or the safety thereof.
- Make sure you understand the task and the risks involved and have a plan to mitigate those risks. Apply Last Minute Risk Assessment. If there is any doubt the work can be performed safely, please contact your PoR contact person and discuss the situation.
- During the work, you shall adhere to the Life Saving Rules (p.t.o.) and:
 - Never disable or override safety equipment
 - Verify that all energy sources are isolated before works begin
 - Arrange a fire watch when performing hot work
 - Do not lead cables or hoses through fire doors or fire hatches
- Maintain a tidy work area and dispose of waste in the agreed manner.
- Report to your PoR contact person when the work is completed.

Our Life Saving Rules

These rules enable us to go home safe and sound



Ensure the escape route is known and available



Do not walk under a suspended load



Drive safe and restrict the use of a phone during driving



Stay clear of moving equipment or vehicles



No alcohol or drugs while working or driving



Protect yourself against a fall when working at height



Wear a life jacket when working close to water
